(8) RACER QUALIFICATIONS

- Any male or female 18 years of age or older as of the race day who can complete the race within the time limit and without getting lost.

- Racers must have successfully completed races that are registered with the International Trail Running Association (ITRA) and have earned points described below. The races must have been completed within the last two years (from November 1, 2021) up until the day before the start date of the race registration for the general category (October 31, 2023).

However, at least one of these races must have been completed within one year (from November 1, 2022) up until the day before the registration start date (October 31, 2023).

FUJI100mi: 10 points or more from up to three races*

KAI70k: 3 points or more from up to two races*

As a special exception, finishers of the Virtual ULTRA-TRAIL Mt.FUJI 2021 and Virtual FUJI /KAI 2023 can use the points they earned by completing the virtual races as qualification points.

Eligibility for donation-based entry

Those who are willing to make the above donation to the Fuji-Hakone-Izu Trail Support, general incorporated association to be used for environmental activities and meet the eligibility requirements for this race.

Please note that the donation is not tax deductible.

Those who use the donation-based entry are not required to pay the additional payment processing fee.

(11) ENTRY CANCELLATION OR CHANGES

- Please be aware that you cannot change the race category or cancel your entry for whatever the reason once you've completed the payment process before the payment deadline. There are no entry fee refunds (full or partial).
- Your entry will become invalid and canceled if we receive your payment after the payment deadline. In this case, your payment will be returned to you minus the designated administrative fee.
- The transfer of the right to participate in the race to another person is NOT allowed.

1) Virtual FUJI/KAI 2023

A virtual event in which participants use the race-synched training app, TATTA, to complete running the distance of the event they enter within a designated period of time.

Race Day : 【Virtual FUJI160K】 Saturday 7 October – Monday 16 October 10days
【Virtual KAI69K】 Tuesday 17 October – Sunday 22 October 6days

Category : Virtual FUJI160K、 Virtual KAI69K

Rule: Using the race-synched training app, TATTA, run the total distance of the event you entered.

Finisher's prize : Certificate of completion in the app, actual finisher's badge, and points that can be used to enter the race: 3 points for the finishers of the Virtual FUJI160k and 1 point for KAI69k

Enter from: RUNNET (or its English webpage for participants outside of Japan)

Entry Period : September 1st (0:00 am JST) ,2023 – September 30, 2023

Fee: 3,000 yen (including tax) * 3,500 yen for participants outside of Japan - the fee includes shipping of a finisher prize.

Other: Virtual FUJI/KAI original T-shirts available for purchase (3,000 yen including tax)

(18) Other

- Shuttle buses will run between Fuji Hokuroku Park and the FUJI100mi start venue (Fujisan Kodomo-no-Kuni). Fees apply, and reservation is required.
- Runner parking will be at Fujisan Parking, Fuji-Q Highland, and Conifer Forest. Reservation is required at the time of race entry registration.
- Access buses will run between JR Mishima Station in Mishima City, Shizuoka and Fujisan Hokuroku Park to encourage the use of public transportation.
- Detailed Rules and Regulations will be released in mid-October.
