Shen Jiasheng and Anna Tarasova Win KAI70k at Mt. FUJI 100



Shen Jiasheng (China) and Anna Tarasova (Spain) emerged victorious in the men's an d women's categories, respectively, in the KAI70k trail running race, part of the Mt. F UJI 100 event. The KAI70k covers a distance of 70.2km with a cumulative elevation g ain of 3,052m.

The KAI70k started and finished at Fuji Hokuroku Park / Mt. Fuji Meisui Stadium (Fuji yoshida City, Yamanashi Prefecture), kicking off at 1:30 PM on Saturday, April 26th. T he number of starters was 950 (188 women and 762 men).

Women's Race

In the women's race, Anna Tarasova, Honoka Akiyama (Japan), and Ruby Raven Lindq uist (USA) led the early stages.

However, Tarasova gradually began to pull away from the others. At the 25km checkp oint "Yamanakako Kirara" (K2), she arrived with a 3-minute lead over Akiyama and Lin dquist. Tarasova continued to extend her lead through the subsequent technical mou ntain sections. Meanwhile, Aurore Dacier de Biasi (FRA) moved into third place, overta king Akiyama.

Anna Tarasova reached the finish line at Fuji Hokuroku Park in 7 hours, 44 minutes, a nd 59 seconds, securing the women's KAI70k title for this year. Ruby Raven Lindquist made a late surge to finish second, crossing the gate just 3 minutes behind in 7 hour s, 48 minutes, and 7 seconds. Aurore Dacier de Biasi followed 25 minutes later in 8 h ours, 13 minutes, and 26 seconds, completing the top three. Sarah Keyes (USA) finis hed fourth, followed by Honoka Akiyama in fifth and Naho Kotani in sixth.

Runner-up Ruby Lindquist, participating in her first race in Japan after traveling from California, USA, commented on the KAI70k course: "It was very beautiful. There were steeper and more technical sections than I expected, and we even used fixed ropes t o climb. I felt really good for most of the race." Reflecting on memorable moments du ring the race, she added, "Running through the trees at dusk as the fog rolled in was a really cool experience."

Men's Race

The men's race saw Jiasheng Shen (China) taking an aggressive lead from the start, p ursued by Marcel Hoeche (Germany).

After leaving the 25km checkpoint "Yamanakako Kirara" (K2), Shen began to extend h is lead, ultimately finishing at Fuji Hokuroku Park in 6 hours, 38 minutes, and 40 seco nds. He was greeted by his family as he won his first race in Japan.

The battle for third place involved several Japanese runners. Sei Koga emerged from the group. He reached the "Fujiyoshida" (K4) checkpoint at the 51km mark in third pl ace, nearly 5 minutes ahead of the runners behind him. He maintained his position to finish in 7 hours, 25 minutes, and 41 seconds, securing a spot in the top three. Ryosh in Hase finished fourth, followed by Naoki Satani in fifth and Tsubasa Azuma in sixth. Jiasheng Shen commented on his race day: "I felt very good today, and the mountain course was wonderful, so I'm very satisfied with my performance." Regarding the KAI 70k course, he reflected, "There were many runnable sections, which suited me very well." He added, "This was my first race in Japan, and I enjoyed it very much. I would d efinitely like to come back often if I have the opportunity," expressing enthusiasm for future participation in Japanese trail running events.

Marcel "Macy" Hoeche, who is currently on an exchange graduate program at a Japan ese university this spring, shared his excitement with the crowd: "The Mt. Fuji 100 has always been a dream trail running race for me, and today I was able to fulfill that drea m. I'm really happy to have finished second."

The KAI70k will reach its final cutoff time at 10:30 AM on Sunday, April 27th, 21 hour s after the start.
