A new race has been added, and the trail running festival will kick off with a record 3,800 participants from 45 countries and regions



The 11th edition of the Mt. FUJI100 will take place over three days from April 25 (Fri) to 27 (Sun). The “FUJI100mi” (Fuji 100 Mile) covers a distance of 168.0 km with a cumulative elevation gain of 6,254 meters, traversing the mountains, forests, and towns at the base of Mount Fuji. The “KAI70k” (Kai 70k) covers a distance of 70.2 km with a cumulative elevation gain of 3,052 meters, corresponding to the latter half of the FUJI100mi course. and the new race “ASUMI40k” (distance 40.2km, cumulative elevation gain 1,445m), named after the Asumi district (Fujiiyoshida City) where the final aid station of each race is located, will be held.

The total number of participants in the three races is expected to reach approximately 3,800, marking the highest number in the history of the event since its inaugural edition in 2012. Participants from overseas will come from a record 45 countries and regions worldwide. Among these, participants from Asian countries and regions, including China, Hong Kong, Thailand, and South Korea, will number 530.

On the morning of April 25, the day before the start of the FUJI100mi, a presentation featuring the selected athletes was held at the Fuji North Foot Park and Fuji Mountain Meisui Stadium. Last year's men's champion, **Guomin DENG (CHN)**, stated, "I am very happy to be back at Mount Fuji. Last year, I won the championship, but this year there are many strong competitors, so I have prepared even more than last year and am ready for today's race." **Tyler Green** (USA), who has finished as runner-up twice at the Western States 100-mile race in the United States, will participate in today's 100-mile race. 'I am truly looking forward to running alongside these amazing athletes. I hope we can all give our best and achieve great times together,' he said with a smile.

Fuzhao Xiang (CHN), who won this race in 2019 and 2023, will be running the newly added ASUMI40k this time. "I am very happy to be back for my third Mount Fuji 100 race," he said.

Claudia Tremps (ESP), who has twice finished as runner-up in the Transgrancanaria race of the Gran Canaria World Trail Majors, said with anticipation ahead of the 100-mile start, "Running around Mount Fuji has always been a dream of mine."

Yuri Yoshizumi (JPN), an elite runner based in Fujiyoshida City, will compete in the ASUMI40k after winning last year's KAI70k. "This is my home, so I'm delighted that so many people from overseas have come here to run," she said, welcoming the gathered runners.

Among the participants in the KAI70k, **Jiasheng SHEN (CHN)** took the stage. "I am very happy to be able to participate in this event. I would like to challenge myself to run 100 miles in the future," he said. **Koji MORIMOTO** (JPN) said, "I am looking forward to running in this wonderful course and venue."

As the host of an international trail running event representing Japan, the areas around Fuji-san welcome trail runners and their families from around the world.
