Guangfu Meng and Fuzhao Xiang Victorious in Inaugural "ASUMI40k" Race



At the Mt. FUJI 100 event, held over three days from Friday, April 25th to Sunday, April 27th, 2025, the inaugural "ASUMI40k" race took place on Saturday, April 26th. Und er favorable conditions with occasional glimpses of Mt. Fuji through the clouds, Guan gfu Meng and Fuzhao Xiang emerged victorious. Both male and female winners were Chinese athletes, topping the podium in the new short-distance race of Japan's premi er international trail running event set against the backdrop of Mt. Fuji. Fuzhao Xiang secured her third victory at this event, following wins in the 2019 UTMF and the 202 3 FUJI100mi.

The race covered a 40.2km course with 1,445m of cumulative elevation gain (D+), sta

rting and finishing at Fuji Hokuroku Park / Fujisan Meisui Stadium (Fujiyoshida City, Y amanashi Prefecture). A total of 218 runners (59 women, 159 men) stood at the start ing line.

Women's Race

The women's race began with Fuzhao Xiang and Yuri Yoshizumi, a leading Japanese tr ail runner based in the host city Fujiyoshida and last year's KAI70k champion, taking t he lead. Fuzhao Xiang pulled ahead as the course turned downhill mid-race. Yoshizum i, stating "I lost sight of Fuzhao's back," pursued diligently, but the gap did not close e asily. Ultimately, Fuzhao Xiang won with a time of 3 hours, 37 minutes, and 33 second s. Yuri Yoshizumi finished second, three and a half minutes behind. Emi Iwai, last yea r's KAI70k runner-up, followed in third place with a time of 3 hours, 51 minutes, and 4 1 seconds. Miho Tsuboi finished fourth, Natsumi Yamauchi fifth, and Nami Ishihara six th.

At the awards ceremony, Fuzhao Xiang expressed her gratitude towards Yuri Yoshizu mi, saying, "I want to thank Yuri Yoshizumi today. We took turns leading, but ultimatel y, luck was on my side, and I was able to win. I hope we can continue to push each ot her and run together in future races."

Men's Race

The men's race was led by Tuomas Kari (Finland), Koken Ogasawara (Japan), and Gua ngfu Meng (China). The competition narrowed down to Meng and Ogasawara during t he final steep climb with a 600m elevation difference. After a close battle in the final s tages, Guangfu Meng claimed victory with a time of 3 hours, 3 minutes, and 29 secon ds, just 18 seconds ahead of runner-up Koken Ogasawara. Tuomas Kari finished third. Takamaru Kawasaki (Japan) was fourth, Tsukasa Shinchi (Japan) fifth, and Ryo Murata (Japan) sixth. Winner Guangfu Meng humbly reflected on his race, stating, "Having jus t run a race last week, winning today was unexpected. The three of us competed clos ely, but I was fortunate to pull slightly ahead on the final climb and secure the win."

The ASUMI40k concluded at its cutoff time of 7:00 PM. Additionally, the "KAI70k," a 7 0.2km race with 3,052m elevation gain that started at 1:30 PM on Saturday, April 26t h, will reach its cutoff time at 3:30 AM on Sunday, April 27th. Similarly, the "FUJI100m i," whose first wave started at 5:00 PM on Friday, April 25th, has a cutoff time of 2:30 PM on Sunday, April 27th.
