**Mt. FUJI 100: ManYee Cheung Wins Women's Race in 23:42:00, Japan's Arika Ito Takes Third**



On the afternoon of Saturday, April 26, 2025, ManYee Cheung (HKG) won the women's FUJI100mi race at the Mt. FUJI 100. She finished in 23 hours, 42 minutes, and 00 seconds, marking her second podium appearance after placing fifth in the 100-mile race at this event in 2019, this time claiming the top spot.

The FUJI100mi is a trail running race that started at 5:00 PM on Friday, April 25, from Fuji Children's World (Fuji City, Shizuoka Prefecture) and finished at Fuji Hokuroku Park / Fujisan Meisui Stadium. The women's race began with Claudia Tremps (ESP), who has finished in the top three for five consecutive years at Transgrancanaria, another race in the Gran Canaria World Trail Majors like this event, taking the lead. However, Tremps suffered an ankle sprain early in the race. Although she continued, she eventually retired from the race at the "Fumoto" (F2) checkpoint at the 52.6km mark. Following Tremps' withdrawal, ManYee Cheung, who had been trailing her, took the lead and maintained it for the remainder of the race. She arrived at Fuji Hokuroku Park in 23 hours, 42 minutes, and 00 seconds, securing the champion's title for this year's Mt. FUJI 100 FUJI100mi race.

In a post-finish interview, Cheung responded to questions, saying, "I'm happy because my condition was better than when I competed six years ago, and I was able to significantly improve my previous time." Regarding taking the lead during the race, she said, "I couldn't believe [I was in the lead]. I knew there was a very fast European female runner, and I thought she should be ahead of me. I think I was lucky [to win]."

Huiping ZHANG (CHN), who significantly moved up in the rankings during the latter half of the course, emerged in second place. She finished 54 minutes behind ManYee Cheung in 24 hours, 35 minutes, and 51 seconds, securing the runner-up position. Japan's Arika ITO (JPN) followed in third place, finishing in the top three with a time of 24 hours, 59 minutes, and 43 seconds. Kanako EDAMOTO (JPN) finished fourth, FangYuan WEN (CHN) fifth, and Junko YANO (JPN), the runner-up in the 100-mile race at this event in 2022, finished sixth.
