### **RACER QUALIFICATIONS**

- Any male or female 18 years of age or older as of the race day who can complete the race within the time limit and without getting lost.

- Racers must have successfully completed races that are registered with the International Trail Running Association (ITRA) and have earned points described below. The races must have been completed within the last two years (from November 1, 2023) up until the day before the start date of the race registration for the general category (October 31, 2025).

However, at least one of these races must have been completed within one year (from November 1, 2024) up until the day before the registration start date (October 31, 2025).

 FUJI100mi : Completion of one race worth 4 or more ITRA points, or two races worth 3 ITRA points each

• KAI70k : Completion of one race worth 2 or more ITRA points

· ASUMI40k : Completion of one race worth 1 or more ITRA points

### Eligibility for donation-based entry

Those who are willing to make the above donation to the Fuji-Hakone-Izu Trail Support, general incorporated association to be used for environmental activities and meet the eligibility requirements for this race.





### **Elite Athlete Participation Qualification (all three events)**

Those who meet the following criteria at the time of entry will be given priority entry rights as elite athletes.

- FUJI100mi

Free invitation: ITRA PI (100k or 100M) Men's 850 or above, Women's 715 or above Paid invitation: ITRA PI (100k or 100M) Men's 800 or above, Women's 650 or above

- KAI70k

Free invitation: ITRA PI (50k or 50M) Men's 865 or more, Women's 740 or more Paid invitation: ITRA PI (50k or 50M) Men's 830 or more, Women's 660 or more

- ASUMI40k

Free invitation slots: ITRA PI (half marathon or marathon or 50k) Men 870 or above,

Women 735 or above

Paid invitation slots: ITRA PI (half marathon or marathon or 50k) Men 820 or above,

Women 650 or above

### **Pregnancy Postponement Policy**

To support female athletes, if pregnancy is confirmed between the time of entry and the race, the entry fee will be fully refunded and the runner's eligibility to participate will be maintained for two years. Female athletes who wish to return to competition after childbirth or childcare will be recognized as eligible to participate based on their performance before pregnancy (within three years of returning).

We will consider what kind of support we can provide to athletes who are breastfeeding before, during, and after the race.

## **Equipment**

Your total equipment must exceed 2kg at the start and when you leave any aid station, and must not be less than 1kg anywhere along the course.

Competitive items may be checked during the race. If any of the compulsory items are missing, you may be disqualified immediately.

The racer is responsible for determining the level of warmth, waterproofness, etc. of the required clothing. The organizer will consider the clothing selected and submitted by the racer to be the required clothing for that racer.

Not only should you have all the equipment, but you should also know how to use it. Check below  $(\checkmark)$  are required items.

### Recommended items to carry





The list of essential items is not sufficient for all runners to run this race. The necessary equipment will vary depending on each runner's skill and physical ability, as well as the weather on the day. Identify the equipment you need and bring additional items with you. Also, try wearing the gear beforehand and experience running in high mountains in subzero temperatures or for long periods in heavy rain to see if it really protects your body. Below is a list of items we particularly recommend bringing with you.

### Particularly recommended items to carry

# Trail running shoes/compass/Bear bell (\*1)/Change of clothes/cash/GPS tracker (IBUKIGPS) (\*2)

- \*1 Bear bells are a very annoying noise for local residents, day or night. In residential areas, bear bells are prohibited and signs stating "No Bear Bells" will be posted, so please refrain from ringing them.
- \*2 This is a GPS tracker that allows you to check the current location of runners in near real time. It can be viewed by anyone during the race. Optional rentals will be available at the event, and those who apply will be given the device at a special booth at the event registration venue.

Simply turning it on and wearing it will allow supporters to transmit their location information. If supporters are using "IBUKI" while waiting for runners, they can move and prepare with ease, and enjoy themselves while they wait. It can also be used to inform family and friends who were unable to be there to cheer on the runners of their current location.
