## **Announcement Regarding Event Implementation (Decision from Meeting Held 3 Days Prior to the Event)**

The organizing committee of Mt.FUJI100 Organizing Committee held a pre-event meeting on April 21, 2026 (Tuesday) at 20:00.

As a result of discussions, it has been decided that the event will proceed as scheduled, with no changes to the course.

According to the latest weather forecast, rainfall is expected from the night of April 23 to the early hours of April 24.

Projected precipitation levels are approximately:

- 30 – 40 mm on the western side of Mt. Fuji (Fujinomiya area)
- 50 – 60 mm on the eastern side (Yamanakako Village area)

Additionally, light rain or drizzle may continue after Friday.

Participants and stakeholders are advised to note the following:

- Fog is expected, and poor visibility may occur, particularly around the Asagiri Plateau in the Fujinomiya area.
- Temperatures are forecast to range between 2°C and 20°C. At present, the risks of snowfall and extreme heat (heatstroke) are considered low.

Starting this year, the event is supported by meteorological advisory services provided by Yamaten Co., Ltd.

The latest weather updates during the event period will be announced at a press conference scheduled for 11:00 on April 24 (Friday) at Fuji Hokuroku Park.
